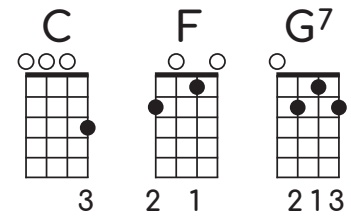


COLORFUL HAWAI'I
